Amberhill Update	AG attended Amberhill with Gavin and TM to set out plan for data sharing agreement between ADVP and Amberhill – in principle agreement for Amberhill to share data with ADVP from Jan 2020  Issues for them to believe it will be of benefit they need to see more intel from members – will need to see outcome reporting  ADVP perspective need to think of process to manage the data and ensure we meet Amberhill requirements as well as providing resource  TM advised this must be on a non-commercial basis  AG cost must be covered by ADVP  Data currently shared with 3 ADVP members  Members must build own API to access the data  AG access to Amberhill database the holy grail for some members  Need to define process and method to cover costs  How do we incentivise those who can to share data  Set up sub group for those who want to gain access  AG to set up Amberhill working group – at this moment comm suggests only those who have signed ISA can participate  AG to send out invite to all comm members – meeting in next couple of weeks  2 options  Provide data – free  Take only – pay  TM cautioned this approach could lead to demise of Amberhill  TM advised if there is no interest then need to try a different approach  Cautioned that if Amberhill does not grow it will close down  Following committee discussion decision to offer take only and pay not viable to
